Someone was bothered by bees and saw them entering and leaving the bee box and decided to spray them and the box with insecticide which made the bees angry and they began to swarm bothering residents of L,M,and N buildings.

The swarming bees bothered people on their balconies and going in and out of there units. Fredy and Sal did their job and reset the bee box and the bees were again attracted and are calling the box home. It takes a few days for the box to fill up, the bees to settle down and be safe for relocation.
